Jackets

- We return to school on Monday April 17th.
- Average temperatures for this time of year: 12-14°C
- Jackets/hoodies/half-zips worn to school **should not be worn on corridors or in classrooms and should be kept in lockers/school bags.**
- All students should be clearly identifiable as students of the Friary at ALL TIMES on corridors and in classrooms.
- If extra layers are needed these should be worn UNDER THE SCHOOL SHIRT AND SHOULD NOT BE VISIBLE.

After the Easter Break..

- Uniform checks will be carried out by class teachers at 9 am and will be monitored throughout the day.
- Students who are not wearing the correct uniform **as shown in the photos** will be assigned lunchtime detention by their 9 am class teacher.
- Detention will be in the STUDY HALL from 1:30 – 1:55 **ON THAT DAY.** Punishment work will be given.
- If **ANY** part of the uniform is missing, detention will be assigned.
- The detention will be recorded/assigned on Eportal when the roll is taken.
- No uniform after lunch results in detention the following day.
- Repeat offenders – Friday afterschool detention will be assigned.
- Uniform stored in school bag or in locker is considered not wearing it.
