Dear Parents/Guardians/Students,

I hope this letter finds you and your family well. I would like to welcome all our students back to St. Augustine's College.

Could all parents/guardians please ensure that you read the information below with your son/daughter before they return to school.

- 3rd and 6th year groups return on Monday 30th of August
- 2nd and 5th year groups return on Tuesday 31th of August
- Transition year groups return on Wednesday 1st of September

**Note

- 1. In line with HSE and Dept of Education Guidelines all student are required to wear a mask in school.
- 2. Drop of point for student is by the bus shelter outside the school grounds. Please do not drive on to school grounds.
- 3. Unfortunately, lockers are not currently available
- 4. Canteen will not be open on the first week. It will reopen on Monday 6th of September
- 5. Timetables for students in 2nd, 3rd, TY, 5th and 6th year will be made live on Eportal later this week. An alert message will be uploaded onto the school app when student timetables become live. It is very important that all students view their weekly timetable on Eportal ahead of their return to school and print out a copy of it. Mobile Phones.



Mobile phones are <u>not</u> permitted. The school policy on this has not changed. However due to Covid-19, the classroom teacher may permit the use of a mobile phone if they wish purely for educational purposes and strictly under the supervision of the classroom teacher. Outside of class and at break times etc the use of mobile phones is strictly NOT permitted. Ensure your child is aware that mobile phones are not to be used inappropriately in school. This includes pictures, videos, Snapchat, TikToc, WhatsApp, Instagram, videos etc of other students and/or staff. Students not presenting in full uniform will be sent to the deputy principal/ principal at/before the 9am class.


2nd/3rd/TY/5th/6th Year.
