Students Study Seven Subjects

All Students must study the following subjects in 5th year:

- English
- Gaeilge *
- Mathematics

Wellbeing Subjects

- SPHE & RSE
- Religion
- Physical Education



* **Exception:** If a student is exempt in Gaeilge/Language due to a Specific Learning Difficulty or educated outside of Ireland up to age 11.



RESEARCH NEEDED CAREER AREA & ESSENTIAL SUBJECTS

After choosing career area, the student must research:

- Essential subject required
- Minimum grade specified.



For example:

• A Third language is essential for the National University of Ireland i.e. NUIC, NUIG, NUID, NUIM.

If in doubt seek advice from the Guidance Counsellor.





SCHOOL DECISIONS

The School must:

- Match the numbers taking various subjects with available staff
- Take class size into account

Sometimes <u>not enough students opt for a certain subject</u> so a clacannot be formed.

Therefore, it is important to have a <u>substitute choice</u> that you have researched and that you are happy with should one of your choices prove not to be feasible.

Choosing subjects does not necessarily mean that you will be able to study them for the Leaving Certificate.



HOW TO CHOOSE SUBJECT LEVEL



Look at:

- Junior Certificate results
- Career area
- Essential subjects & level requirements

Advice:

- Start at the higher level and keep the head down.
- It is easier to drop to a lower level.

Subject choice should not depend on:

- Teacher
- Rumours about 'easy' subjects.





Royal College of Surgeons: all courses require a 3rd language.



How to Rank Subjects for 5th year






Subject Options Form How to Rank Subjects

- Preference No.5 & No.6 are the backup choices.
- (these may be used where timetabling constraints exist.
 - Subjects you need must be in your top 3
 - We always try to give students their top 2/3 choices
 - Circle the correct level for English/Irish/Mathematics
 - If a student wishes to take L.C.V.P then No. 2 & No. 3 must fall into L.C.V.P Vocational Groupings.



If a student requires a subject transfer they must contact the Guidance Counsellor by mid September 2020. <u>Transfer</u> will depend on availability (Class size or subject line bands).
