Dear Parents/Guardians/Students,

I hope this letter finds you and your family well. I would like to welcome all our first year students to St. Augustine's College.

Could all parents/guardians please ensure that you read the information below with your son/daughter before they return to school.

1st year students start school on Thursday 26th of August at 9am and will finish at 1.15pm.

Classes on Friday will also finish at 1.15pm.

**Note

- 1. In line with HSE and Dept of Education Guidelines all student are required to wear a mask in school.
- 2. Drop of point for student is by the bus shelter outside the school grounds. Please do not drive on to school grounds.
- 3. There is no need to carry books initally.
- 4. Please bring some copy books and stationary plus a snack for break.
- 5. 1st year parents/guardians will not have access to Eportal until mid-September. 1st year students will be issued a printed timetable plus school student diary on day 1 of school. Parents/guardians of incoming 1st year students will be issued Eportal login details by mid-September. To help students settle into secondary school, and to promote student wellbeing all first year students will be assigned a teacher mentor.

Ahead of returning to school it is very important that all students submit the <u>return to school</u> declaration form.

This is available on the school app from which you will receive notifications over next few days. However, we would request that in order to speed up registration on Thursday morning, that if possible you would also print off a paper version from link below.

Mobile Phones.



Mobile phones are <u>not</u> permitted. The school policy on this has not changed. However due to Covid-19, the classroom teacher may permit the use of a mobile phone if they wish purely for educational purposes and strictly under the supervision of the classroom teacher. Outside of class and at break times etc the use of mobile phones is strictly NOT permitted. Ensure your child is aware that mobile phones are not to be used inappropriately in school. This includes pictures, videos, Snapchat, TikToc, WhatsApp, Instagram, videos etc of other students and/or staff.
