Dear Parents / Guardians / Students

I hope this letter finds you and your family well.

I would like to commend the excellent effort that is being made by all our students and teaching staff at the Friary.

It has come to my attention that a 'WhatsApp' group of 2nd year students is in existence and a large number of 2nd year students are participants in this group. I have not seen this content and I am also not aware who created the app or who posted the inappropriate content however I am appealing to every single parent/guardian to sit down with their son/daughter and to ask them to show them their Whatsapp groups and ensure the content is appropriate.

This is not a school sanctioned, endorsed or monitored forum and my advice is that if your child is a member of the 2nd year group chat that you would ensure that they remove themselves from it. I have no doubt that it was set up with good intentions but I feel that if there has been inappropriate content posted that it is best to nip this in the bud for everyone's safety

I would also ask each parent/guardian to please;

- 1. Check your child's mobile phone and monitor that there is no inappropriate material on their phone or being distributed. This includes pictures, videos, Snapchat, WhatsApp and all other social media app's /forums. - 2. Check the School App regularly.
